# New General Application Regulations 2007

## Seminar with Raymond Byrne

The New General Application Regulations 2007 (SI No.299 of 2007) come into force on **1st November 2007**. This half-day seminar with Raymond Byrne will inform you what's **really new** and what's mainly a repeat of existing Regulations, including the General Application Regulations 1993 (SI No.44 of 1993). This seminar will also bring you up to date with all other developments in health and safety law, so that you and your organisation are fully prepared for the new legal environment.

### Raymond Byrne

Raymond Byrne is a barrister and lecturer in law at Dublin City University, where he is also chair of the Graduate Diploma/MBS programme in safety and health at work. Since 2003, he has also been Director of Research at the Law Reform Commission. He is author of *Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Law in Ireland* (nifast, 2001; new edition in preparation) and a founding member of the Health and Safety Lawyers Association of Ireland. He is also co-author of *The Irish Legal System* (4th ed, 2001) and of the *Annual Review of Irish Law* series.

### Who should attend?

### All the really new elements in the 2007 Regulations will be covered

- Fire safety: what's the drill and who will enforce the new rules?

- What's the effect of the new rules that employees should be "ergonomically supported"?
- Does the reference to lone working mean more duties on employers?
- What's the effect of including specific minimum temperatures for workplaces?
- Can you track from the old Regulations into the new Regulations?

- Why did the European Court of Justice give the nod to "reasonably practicable"?
- A new law on corporate manslaughter comes to Ireland (Northern Ireland)
- Could decisions of Rights Commissioners on "penalisation" under the 2005 Act conflict with the powers of the HSA?
- What's holding up On-the-Spot Fines?
- What EU Directives are due for implementation and when?
