The General Application Regulations 2007 (SI No.299 of 2007) came into force on 1st November 2007. This Seminar from Nifast follows up on the successful seminars last year with new information on the 2007 Regulations.

The Seminar will cover:

- The changes made by the General Application (Amendment) Regulations 2007 (SI No.732 of 2007), which came into force on 12 November 2007, including changes on PAT (portable appliance testing) and lifting equipment;
- The Guidance issued by the Health and Safety Authority on the 2007 Regulations, which gives a real insight into how the HSA will enforce the new Regulations;
- Other new Guidance from the HSA, including the duties of managers and directors.

The seminar also brings you up to date with all other developments in health and safety law, so that you and your organisation are fully compliant with the new legal environment.

The Seminar will also review the other new elements in the 2007 Regulations and all other developments:

- Fire safety: what the new rules mean and who will enforce the new rules?
- Lifting equipment: how do we compare with the British LOLER Regulations?
- Lone working policies
- Will something like the new law on corporate manslaughter in Northern Ireland be enacted in the Republic?
- Are On-the-Spot Fines on their way in 2008?
- What EU Directives are due for implementation and when?

Since 2003, he has also been Director of Research at the Law Reform Commission. He is author of *Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Law in Ireland*, 2nd edition (nifast, 2008) and a founding member of the Health and Safety Lawyers Association of Ireland. He is also co-author of *The Irish Legal System* (4th ed, 2001) and of the *Annual Review of Irish Law* series.
